



## LOCAL RULES

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)

- a) Beyond any hedge or fence bounding the course.
- b) Beyond any line of white stakes or white line bounding the course.
- c) Beyond the perimeter fence of the Driving Range.

**NOTE:** A ball which crosses the railway line defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond the railway line is out of bounds, even though it may be on another part of the course.

### 2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

Defined by YELLOW stakes and/or lines.

### 3. LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

Defined by RED stakes and/or lines.

### 4. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25)

- a) Any area enclosed by a continuous white line or appropriately signposted.
- b) Tractor tyre marks.

### 5. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES

identified by a stake or tube. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b (Immovable

Obstruction). If the ball lies in a water hazard, the player shall lift and drop the ball in accordance with the Rule 24-2b (Note 1) except that the nearest point of relief must be in the water hazard and the ball must be dropped in the water hazard or the player may proceed under Rule 26. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

### 6. STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies).

### 7. POWER LINES

If a ball strikes a power line or pole, the player must disregard that stroke, abandon the ball and play another ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played in accordance with Rule 25-5 (Playing Next Stroke from where Previous Stroke Played).

### 8. PRACTICE

The area behind the 9<sup>th</sup> putting green comprising

an area for chipping, a bunker and a practice putting green is an integral part of the course on which practice is permitted on the day of a competition. The practice putting green is a "wrong putting green". Rule 25-3 applies.

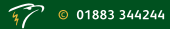
